Why Marriage Matters Arizona (WMMAZ) is a grassroots public education campaign to build support for marriage equality in Arizona. This campaign is about having conversations and sharing stories, showing that same-sex couples and their families should be welcomed and treated fairly in Arizona. This project was founded by Equality Arizona, the ACLU of Arizona, the Human Rights Campaign, and Freedom to Marry. WMMAZ has an immediate opening for a Faith Director. We are looking for an energetic and self-motivated individual to join our team focused on increasing support of marriage for all loving and committed couples.

Job Responsibilities

The Faith Director will work in Arizona to identify and train faith leaders across a broad scope of religions and denominations that support marriage equality. She or he will engage faith leaders in the work of recruiting congregations and people of faith to promote conversations about the importance of marriage for same-sex couples and their families.

The Faith Director will report to the Project Director and work closely with campaign leadership to set goals for the faith program.

The Faith Director will be based in Phoenix, with frequent statewide travel.

Experience Desired:

- Minimum two (2) years experience in working in and mobilizing communities of faith and clergy.
- Experience in faith messaging, particularly around LGBT rights and equality.
- Experience in grassroots or community organizing, including direct voter contact highly preferred
- Demonstrated experience in recruiting, motivating, and training volunteers
- Proficiency working with clergy, lay leaders and people of faith
- Experience working on issues of relevance to the LGBT community
- Experience organizing within communities of color strongly desired
- Reliable personal transportation and availability to work nights and weekends is required.
