practice, or custom of making or threatening to make plea offers harsher in response to people exercising their right to a preliminary hearing and/or trial, but who have not yet made the decision to affirm or waive their preliminary hearing, or reject or accept their initial plea offer; and

- (b) The Post-Waiver Class, defined as all current and future people whom the MCAO has charged and assigned to Maricopa County's EDCs, and who are subject to MCAO's blanket policy, practice, or custom of making or threatening to make plea offers harsher in response to people exercising their right to a preliminary hearing and/or trial, but who have waived their preliminary and/or rejected their initial plea offer.
- (3) Pursuant to Rule 23(g), the Court hereby appoints Plaintiffs' counsel—the American Civil Liberties Union Foundation and the American Civil Liberties Union Foundation of Arizona—as class counsel for the Pre-Waiver Class and the Post-Waiver Class.
