LEGAL PROGRAM - The ACLU Foundation of Arizona provides legal representation to persons whose civil liberties are threatened or violated. In fiscal year 2012, we maintained a docket of 10 active cases challenging violations by government. The organization filed 10 new cases and 3 new friend-of-the-court briefs, and sent 30 demand letters on government policies and/or actions that violated civil liberties. The organization was able to maintain a sizeable legal docket thanks to the donated legal services from local attorneys totaling approximately \$1,644,764 during fiscal year 2011-2012. The ACLU Foundation of Arizona processed 1,972 complaints from community members seeking legal assistance from the ACLU Foundation of Arizona.
